- Tickets should be booked to Fayetteville Regional Airport (FAY) to arrive on July 5 and depart on August 1, 2017. Accommodation cannot be provided prior to July 5 or after August 1, 2017. Transportation from other airports cannot be accommodated.
- Students should carry money for personal expenditure and shopping if desired.
- **Letter of Invitation will be issued by FSU for visa application**

Fee	Amount
Academic Fees: This fee covers tuition and fees for instruction & lab; placement testing and a certificate of completion. The application fee of \$100 will be applied to academic fees.* *The application fee can be paid through a web portal. Information on payment process will be provided in early 2017.	\$1,500
Residential Fees: This fee covers the cost of accommodations in campus residential housing, cost of accommodation in Washington D.C.; meals while on campus of FSU (meals while on excursion are the responsibility of the participant); access to university facilities including networking; access to student life and safety services; and bus passes for local transportation.	\$1,200
Co-curricular Programming Fees: This fee includes transportation and arrangements to local and out-of-state cultural trips, transportation to and from FAY Regional airport to FSU; shopping excursions to club and outlet malls, and a wide range of social activities.	\$400

- December 2016- Promotional materials will be sent to your institution and made available to you to share with family/parents
- March 15, 2017-Application Deadline. Application form and \$100 non-refundable deposit due at this time. Deposit applicable towards total cost.
- March 25-April 5, 2017- FSU will mail invitation letters to applicants for visa application
- ► May 30, 2017-Confirmation of visa issuance
- ▶ July 5, 2017- Arrival at FSU campus
- August 1, 2017- Departure from FSU
